Soroptimistclub Slatina, Romania and Arendal-Grimstad soroptimistclub, Norway, are working for 4 villages to get clean water.

Water bottles are distributed so that the youngest and weakest will survive.

Permanent solutions are needed in the villages for everybody to improve their health.

Purpose:

Clean water for everyone!

Currently we have focus on the most vulnerable: the youngest children and their mothers.

Goal:

- Long term: Clean water for 4 villages.
- Current: Distribution of water bottles.
- Information to the public about the importance of clean water.

Start

President of Slatina soroptimistclub Victoria Ciucu met Christian Steel at a conference. The contact between her and Christian's mother, Mette Steel from Arendal-Grimstad soroptimistclub, led our club to want to get involved.

Why

In the same county as Slatina, there are the 4 villages that are independent municipalities, Schitu, Izvarte, Maruntei and Crampoia. The inhabitants of these villages are struggling with significant health problems due to contaminated drinking water. This leads to high infant mortality, poor immune function that inhibits the development of children, various serious diseases and increased risk of cancer etc. Slatina soroptimistclub wanted to help, and needed a business partners.


Water sample Start 2004

A total of 114 water samples from 89 public wells have been analyzed.

Results: High levels of ammonia, nitrites, nitrates, coli form bacteria and streptococci are found in the water.

What has been done so far?

• The Slatina soroptimist club have had contact with local health carers, doctors, nurses and social workers and political leaders in the villages and in the county of Olt.

• NB! Romania has committed itself through its membership in the EU that all rural districts will have water and sewer conditions within 2017.

What happens next?

· Continue with the local emergency measures.

- Continue working with the SI club in Slatina, and through them, cooperate with local and central authorities.
- Provide funding for the various solutions for the 4 villages.



• Application for EU / EEA via SI club in Slatina and Christian Steel.

• Contact with our local specialist in Romania who can guide us about the requirements for a pilot.
